This had been delayed due to Covid-19.
<b>25<sup>th</sup> February 2019</b>	DNPH.ETE.31 PETITION – TO CLOSE THE ACCESS BETWEEN THE SPINNEY AND THE LAWNS, GRIMSBY.	<b>Public Paths Officer</b>	Update at the meeting on 28 <sup>th</sup> September 2020:-  On the petition to close the access between The Spinney and The Lawns in Grimsby, Mr Nearney confirmed officers were waiting for residents to compile and submit evidence of any anti-social behaviour for their case.
<b>30<sup>th</sup> September 2019</b>	DPH.ETE.19 PETITION IN SUPPORT OF RESIDENTS PARKING ON KEW ROAD AND ELM GARDENS, CLEETHORPES	<b>Traffic Team Manager</b>	Update at the meeting on 28 <sup>th</sup> September 2020:-  On the petition regarding the creation of residents parking permits on Kew Road and Elm Gardens in Cleethorpes, Ms Swatman confirmed officers had received feedback from the surveys that were being reviewed. She confirmed that it was being looked at as a priority and as part of the wider parking scheme. Proposals were being drawn up and the next steps, once agreed with the ward councillors would be to go out to consultation with the residents. The portfolio holder requested that this scheme be carried out as a matter of urgency due to the length of time this process had taken.

Mr Lear confirmed that the Planning Committee on the 22 <sup>nd</sup> July 2020 approved the proposed diversion, the order had been made and that would have a 28 day consultation period with the hope that that the public footpath work would be implemented in October 2020.
