**RE – APPLICATION TO TRANSFER A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER S.42 OF  
THE LICENSING ACT 2003 (Spice of Life, Grimsby)**

I write on behalf of the Chief Constable of Humberside Police. The Chief Constable wishes to object to the transfer application.

The application requests that the business is transferred to Tale & Spirit Group Ltd.


The premises is currently awaiting a Review Hearing due to Illegal workers being found working at the premises.

Tale & Spirit Group is currently running another premises in the area, where the son of the current Licence holder for Spice of Life is the DPS and point of contact. It is therefore not believed that this is an independent party coming in to run the premises, and may still be subject to the criminality that is lined to the premises.

The grounds that the Chief Constable relies upon are that if granted, it would undermine the Prevention of Crime and Disorder Licensing objectives. The facts that the Chief Constable relies on in support of the application are detailed in a Statement that is to follow.

The Chief Constable reserves the right to serve further evidence in support of these representations and to expand, where possible, on the representations at any hearing in relation to the objections.
