

**PORTFOLIO HOLDER
ENVIRONMENT AND
TRANSPORT
DECISION NOTICE**

Publication Date: 18th October 2022

At the meeting of the Portfolio Holder – Environment and Transport, held on the 17th October 2022 the following matters were discussed. The decisions of the Portfolio Holder are set out below in each item along with reasons for the decision and other options considered.

DNPH.ETE.5 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

There were no apologies for absence received for this meeting.

DNPH.ETE.6 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The Portfolio Holder declared a personal interest in agenda item 6 as a Parish Councilor for Immingham Town Council.

DNPH.ETE.7 HIGHWAY WINTER SERVICE REVIEW

The report dealt with the annual review of the Council's highway winter service policy and operational plan. The policy and operational plan establish the framework for the provision of service to the travelling public on the highway network in North East Lincolnshire during the winter season.

RESOLVED – That the highway winter service policy and operational plan (2022-23) be approved.

REASONS FOR DECISION - As a highway authority the Council is required to review its policy and operational plan for highway winter service on an annual basis.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED – The report sets out minor changes and given the role is a statutory one, it is not considered that there are any other reasonable options. The Council could engage less but that would only reduce potential effectiveness with no material counter benefits.

DNPH.ETE.8 THE BOROUGH OF NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2022

It was proposed to introduce a permanent 'Prohibition of Vehicles' restriction within Grimsby Town Centre that would continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) currently in operation.

RESOLVED –

1) That the proposed amendments to the class of vehicles permitted in the council car parks. This is specific to Camper Vans, Motor Caravans or Quad Bikes as specific classes of vehicle be approved.

2) That the commencement of 'The Borough of North East Lincolnshire Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2022' for consultation in accordance with statutory requirements. Exercising its powers under Sections 32, 35, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of all other enabling power and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act be approved.

3) That subject to no objections being received, the making of the Parking Places Order, as detailed in attached appendices be approved.

4) That in the event that there were unresolved objections to the Order, these are referred back to the Portfolio Holder for determination and decision as to whether or not the Parking Places Order are confirmed be approved.

REASONS FOR DECISION - To introduce a new Parking Order following Cabinet's Decision of the 9th March 2022, and seek amendment to the proposal to not allow parking for Camper Vans, Motor Caravans or Quad Bikes as specific classes of vehicle.

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED –

- 1) Do nothing. To not progress with a new Parking Order would mean the way the council use their car parks does not reflect the approach taken to regenerate the Borough.
- 2) Take forward Cabinet approved recommendations from 9 March 2022.
