Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions for premises licences and club premises certificates (Conditions 1 & 2 do not apply to clubs)

Premises licensed to sell or supply alcohol for consumption OFF the premises only

MC1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

MC2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

MC3.

(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy. (Not clubs)

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—

- (a) a holographic mark, or
- (b) an ultraviolet feature.

MC4. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- CCTV shall be installed at the premises and shall cover entry and exit points, the store area, the sales counter and areas where alcohol is displayed.
- All CCTV recording shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days
- Staff shall receive regular training
- A refusals log shall be kept and entries made of all occasions where staff have requested identification prior to sales of alcohol
- A list of staff authorised to sell alcohol at the premises shall be displayed
- A waste bin shall be provided to the exterior of the premises
- Alcohol shall not be consumed in the premises
- Challenge 25 material shall be displayed at the premises
- 'Alcopops' shall not be located for sale adjacent to the confectionary
