WHILST OF ITSELF ONLY A MINOR ALTERATION TO THE PREMISES LICENSE, EVERY SUCH AMENDMENT IGNORES PUBLIC NUISANCE OF UNACCEPTABLE NOISE EMISSIONS THAT AFFECT THE AMENITY OF LOCAL CHALET PARK RESIDENCES AT THE FITTIES, WHICH IN TURN CAUSES RESENTMENT AND SLEEPLESSNESS.

② YET ANOTHER ATTEMPT BY THORPE PARK TO RETAIN HOLIDAY MAKERS ON THEIR SITE, PREVENTING MONEY BEING SPENT ELSEWHERE IN THE RESORT.

If possible please suggest alterations to the application that would resolve the problem mentioned above, again paying attention to the licensing objectives

TO RESOLVE ① ABOVE, EITHER INSTALL NOISE-EMISSION PREVENTION EQUIPMENT, OR RELOCATE THE ENTERTAINMENT FACILITIES.

TO RESOLVE ② DON'T GRANT THE LICENSE AMENDMENT.

SINCE OWNING MY CHALET FOR 17 YEARS THE PREVIOUSLY NAMED 'AQUA BAR' (NOW KNOWN AS 'MARINER'S LOUNGE') HAS CAUSED NUMEROUS COMPLAINTS AGAINST UNACCEPTABLE NOISE EMISSIONS DURING SEASONAL PEAKS CAUSING LOCALS TO AVOID BEING OUTSIDE FOR LONG PERIODS, AND RESULTANT LOSS OF AMENITY.
