# Which of the licensing objectives does your representation refer to? (Select all that apply): Prevention of Public Nuisance

**Prevention of public nuisance:** The NELC licensing policy document in section 9.4 states that public nuisance includes noise and also that, The Licensing Authority wishes to maintain and protect the amenity of residents. How is this done given that there was no information on noise impact in the planning application for the extension to the showbar? Sky lights have been added to the roof closest to the Fitties and are very likely to be opened in warmer weather to aid ventilation. New exit doors have also

been added on that side and are also likely to be open at times as this already happens with the current single exit door. The increase in size is significant as will be the capacity. More people and open air terraces will lead to an incremental increase in the noise environment. How is this factored in to your decision?

If possible please suggest alterations to the application that would resolve the problem mentioned above, again paying attention to the licensing objectives: Carry out an assessment of the noise impact from this change and also look at the existing complaints
