The Prevention of Crime and Disorder	The venue has recently had significant vandalism late at night and having late night drinking has the potential for this to return.
Public Safety	The applicant Andy McCluskey is stating that he has retired, this is incompatible with his role at the venue and being stated as the applicant for the variation of a premises licence.
Prevention of Public Nuisance	Potential public nuisance due to the extended late night opening hours of 23:30. There are residential properties across the road from the venue and it is inevitable that they would be disturbed by the noise this venue would create and people leaving the venue late at night.

The venue has currently permission for drinking and music until 22:30 to prevent disturbance to the residential amenity this should remain and the extension refused.
